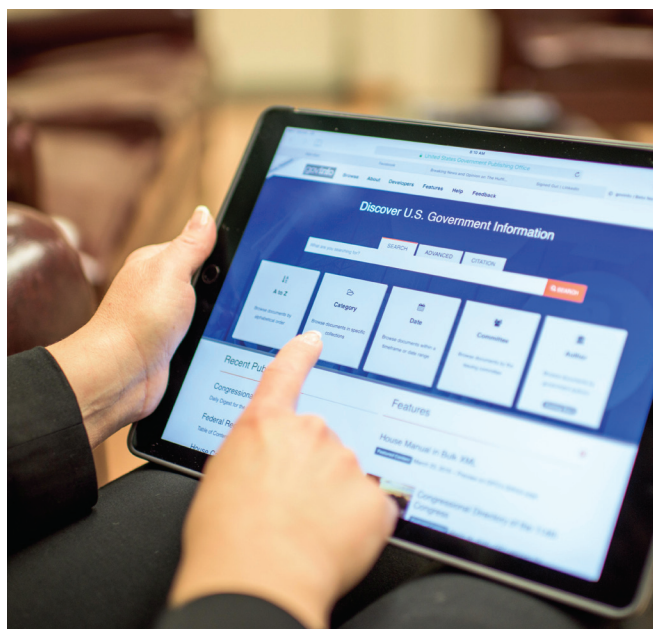

Finding related documents in the legislative process

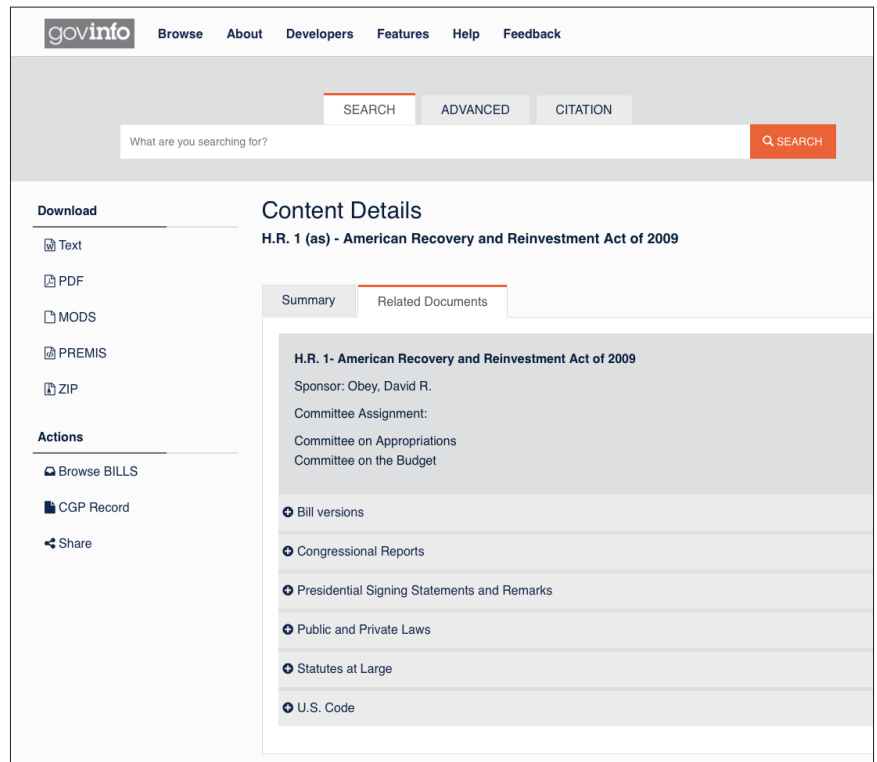
On the **Content Details** page of certain documents in the Congressional Bills, Public and Private Laws, Congressional Reports, Congressional Record, and Compilation of Presidential Documents collections, you can now link directly to documents related to the same piece of legislation:

- Congressional Bill versions
- Congressional Reports
- the Public or Private Law
- Presidential Signing Statement and Remarks
- Statutes at Large
- U.S. Code citations that reference the legislation

On the **Content Details** of certain documents in the Federal Register collection, you can now link to the following related documents:

- *Federal Register* rulemaking documents that share a Regulatory ID Number
- CFR documents referenced by that *Federal Register* document
